Recertification journey examples:

Associate e.g. CTMA	Passed exam on Oct 1, 2024 OR Automatically recertified on Oct 1, 2024	Recertify annually	Requirements must be met by <u>Oct 1, 2024</u>
Specialist e.g. CAMS	Passed exam in Dec 2024 OR Recertified in 2024	Recertify every 3 years	Recertify by <u>Dec 2027</u> <small>Last chance: Mar 2028*</small>
Advanced Specialist e.g. CAMS-FCI	Passed exam in Jan 2024 OR Recertified in 2024	Recertify every 3 years	Recertify by <u>Dec 2027</u> <small>Last chance: Mar 2028*</small>

Recertifying multiple designations



Associate

Each associate-level certification will **automatically recertify one year after the exam/recertification date**, provided credit requirements are met and membership is active.



Specialist

If you have multiple specialist-level designations and wish to maintain all of your designations, you must **recertify each one separately**.



Advanced Specialist

You do not need to recertify all of your advanced specialist designations – **only the one that you earned most recently**. By recertifying your most recent designation, you will maintain any previously earned advanced specialist-level designations, as well as your CAMS designation.

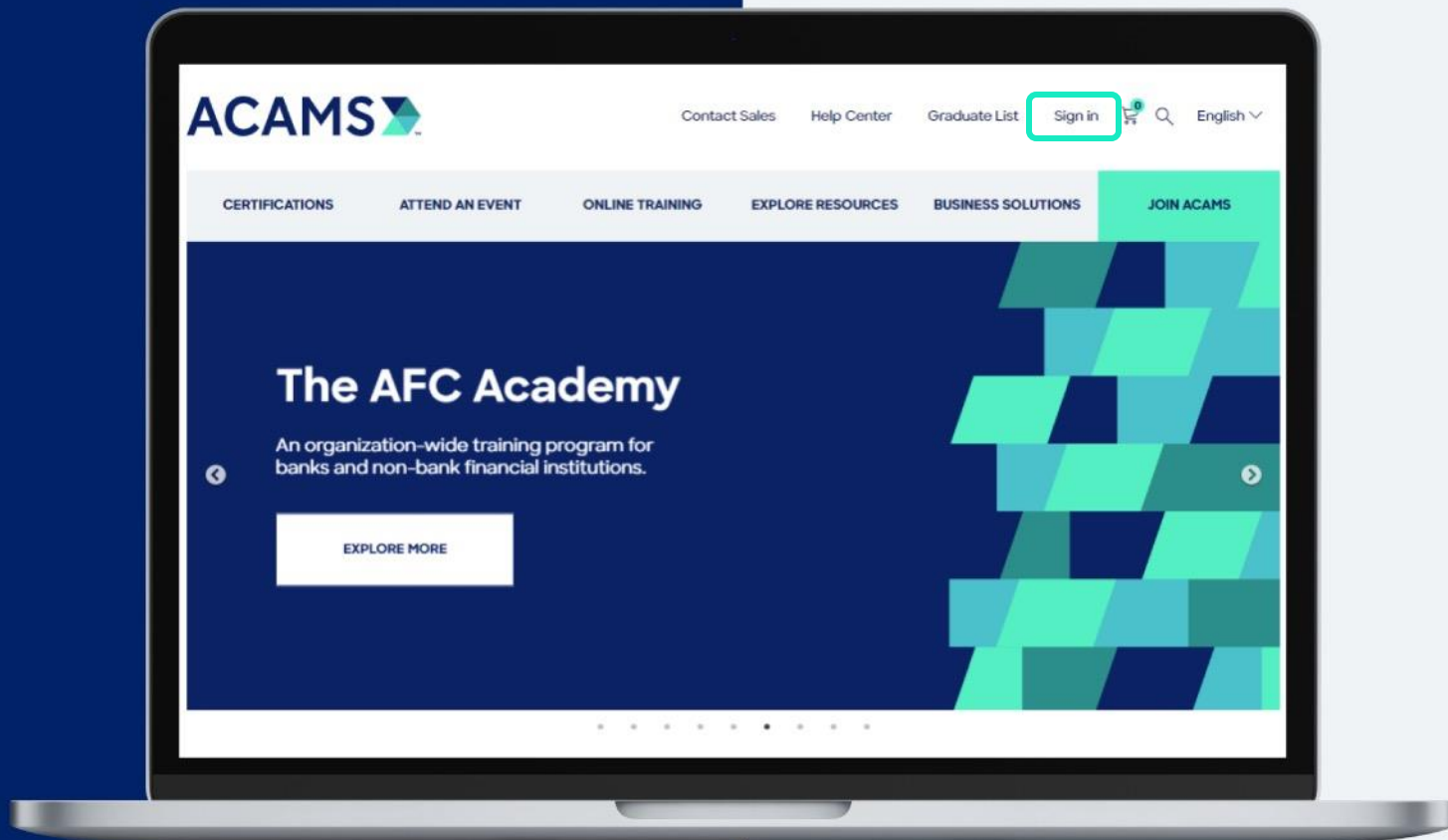

Your ACAMS My Account Page

Your ACAMS **My Account** page has information you will need as you fill out your recertification application. Here, you will find:

- Your membership type and expiration date
- Your educational credits
- Your certification expiration date

Once you have successfully signed in, please click on “My Account”, and then on “Account Home”.

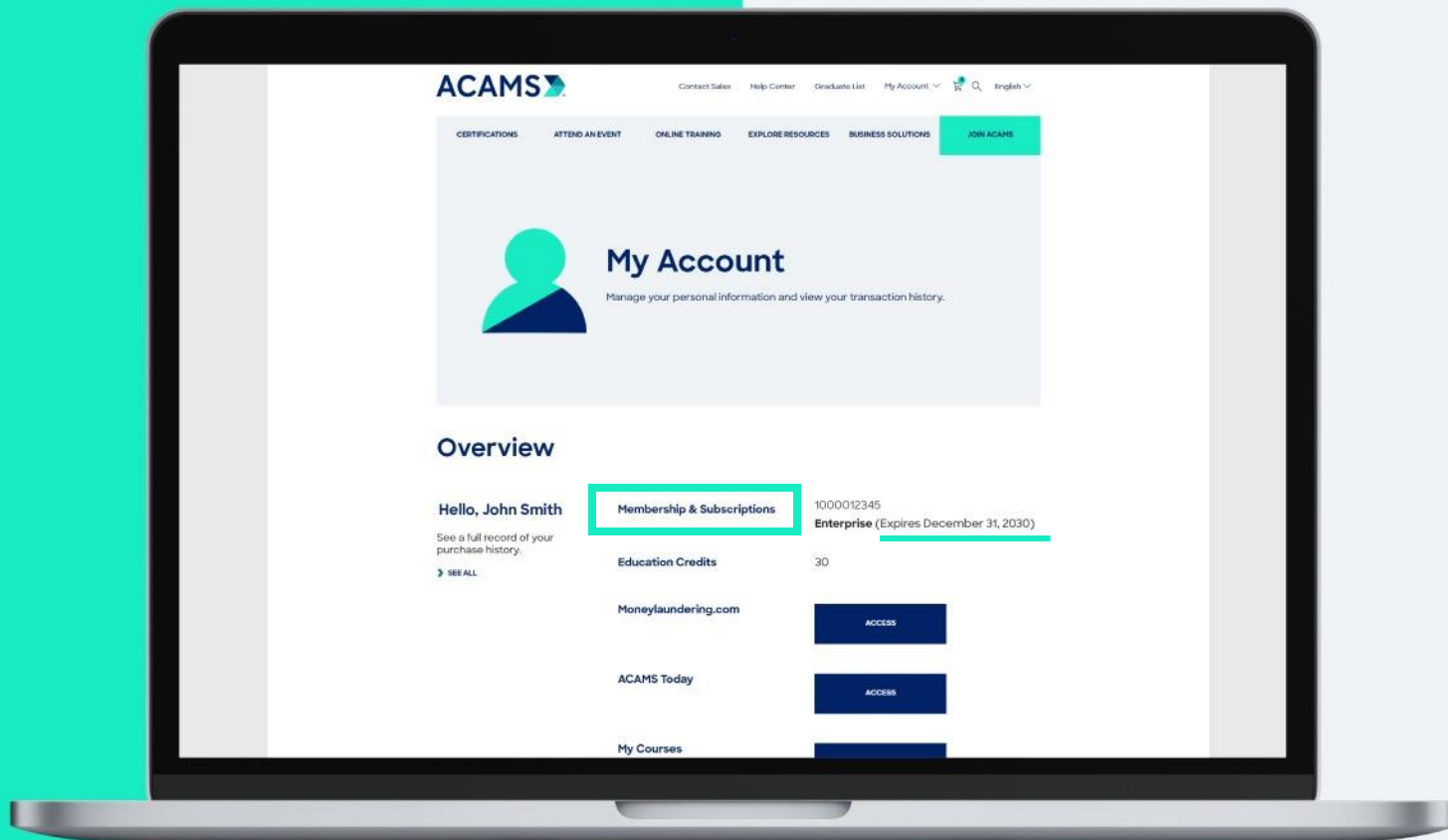
This will take you to your “My Account” page.

- ACAMS certification status

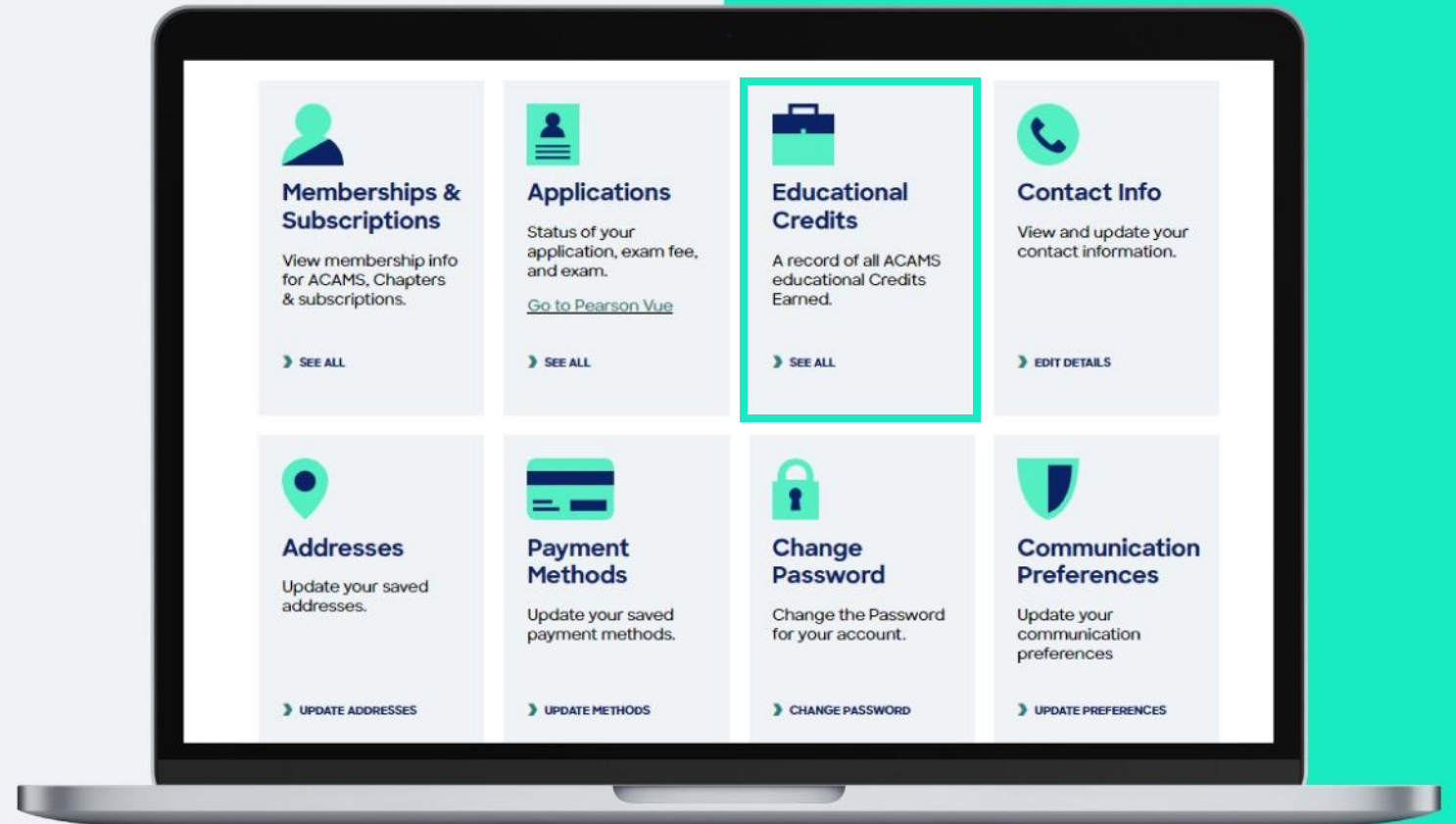


Membership expiration

- Under **Membership & Subscriptions**, you will find your membership **expiration date**. Your membership must be active (not expired) to be eligible for recertification.

Your Educational Credits

- To complete your recertification, ACAMS asks you to provide evidence of your continuing education in the form of recertification credits.
- Click on “See All” under **Educational Credits**. Here, you will find the number of **ACAMS credits** you have earned for the lifetime of your account.

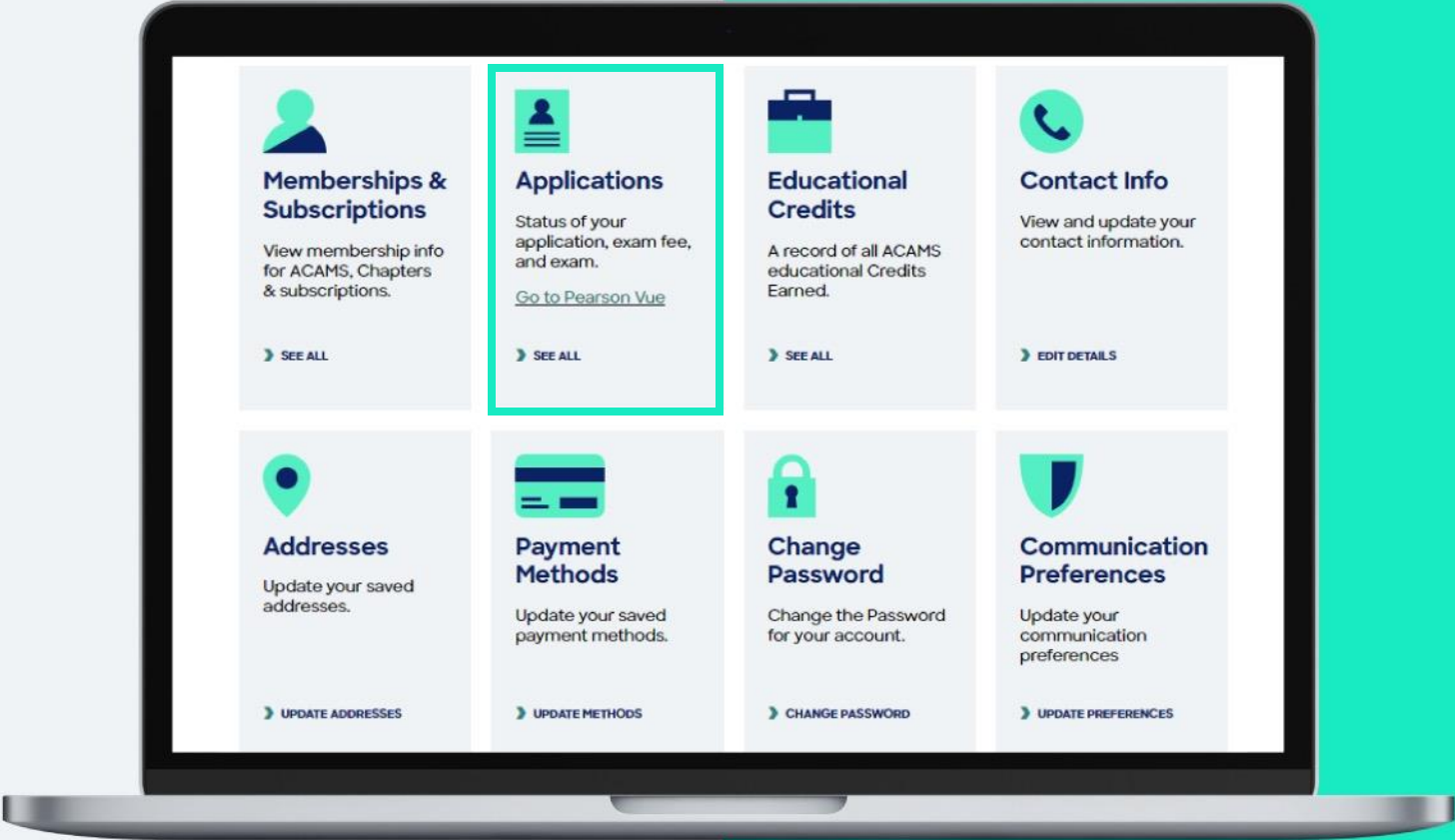


Credits

- You can accrue recertification credits through training (ACAMS or otherwise) and professional experience. Here, you will only be able to see the credits you have accrued through ACAMS.
- You will need to add up your credits based on the requirements of your certification.
- All of your credits must have been earned in the time period since you obtained your certification (or since your most recent recertification).

Active, no action required

Your certification is considered active, with no action required at this time, if:

- It is not expired.
- It does not expire in the current year.

- In this example, assume the current year is 2024. The credential expiration date is December 15, 2025.
- The user does not need to recertify this year.

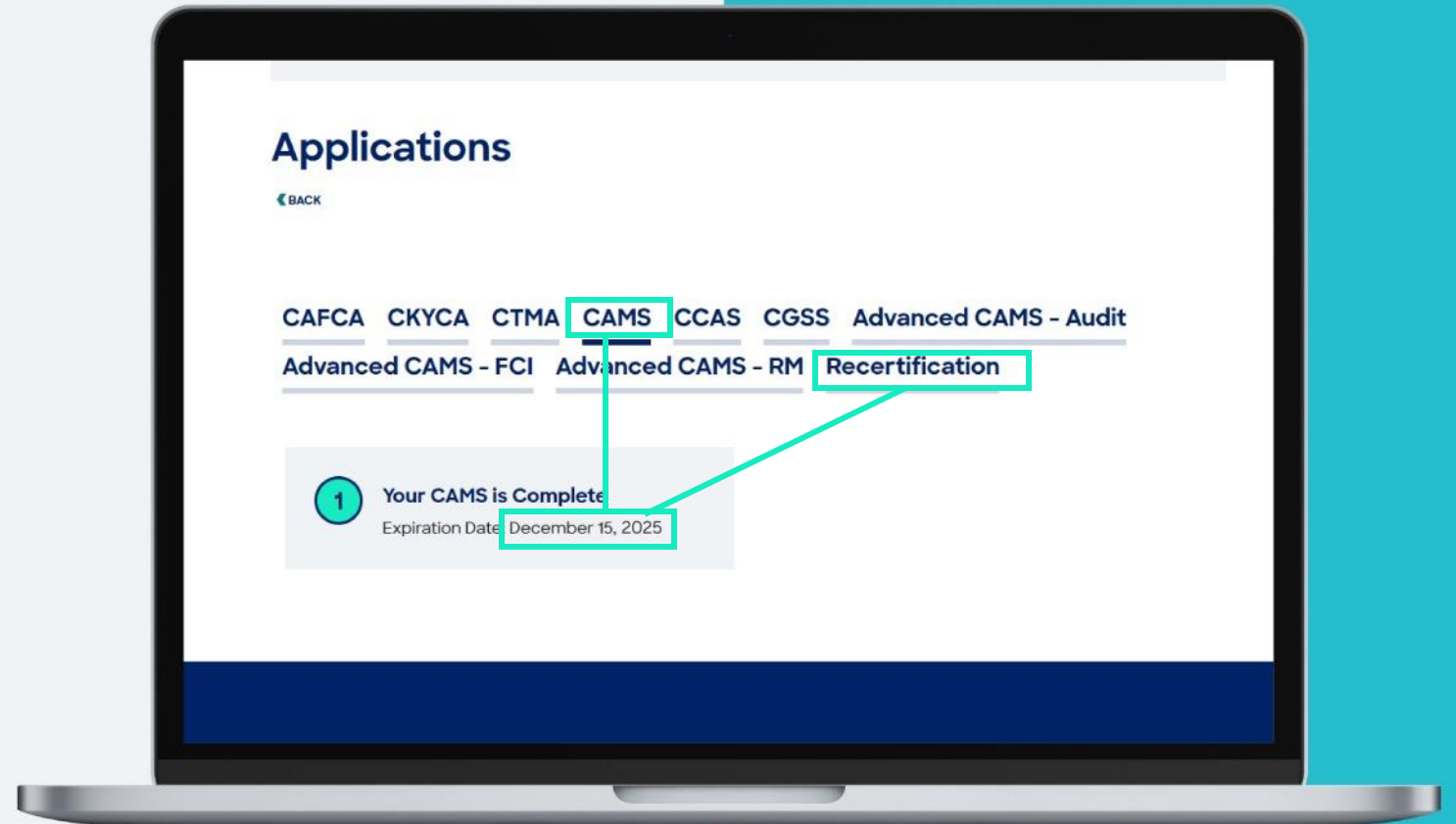
Recertification required

Recertification is required, if:

- It expires in the current year.

This means you need to recertify before December 15 of the current year.

- In this example, assume the current year is 2024. The expiration date is December 15, 2024, so the user needs to recertify within the year.
- There will be a “Recertification” option available in the page, click on that option to apply recertification.

Expired

Your certification is considered expired if:

- **It expired before the current year.**

This means you need to either recertify or take the certification test again.

- This example assumes the current year is 2024. The credential expiration date is December 15, 2020. The certification has expired.




How to Submit a **Recertification Application**

Your recertification application

Along with personal information, you will be asked to provide information about your eligibility. Your eligibility is based on your membership status and credits (which you can get for things like professional experience, relevant training, etc.).
